| 01 | THIS MOU is made on this 2 <sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2019 at Indore between School of Economics, <b>Devi Ahilya University, Indore</b> having its Office at Khandwa Road, Indore represented by Head ,School of Economics , Devi Ahilya University, Indore hereinafter referred to as the <b>DAVV</b> (which term shall mean and include wherever the context as admits or requires its successors, administrators and assigns) and Second Part The <b>Eva Welfare Organization, 179 Sec-B MIG Colony, Indore</b> represented by Director (which term shall mean and include wherever the context so requires or admits his/her heirs, successors, administrators, executors, attorneys and assigns) |
| 02 | WHEREAS The <b>Eva Welfare Organization, Indore</b> engaged in the task of rural and urban development activities. <b>The School of Economics, DAVV, Indore</b> proposes to join the hand of <b>Eva Welfare Organization</b> .  |
| 03 | The <b>Eva Welfare Organization</b> is agreed to accept the proposal of The School of Economics, DAVV to work mutually in the welfare of the society.   |
| 04 | The School of Economics, DAVV shall depute its students and teachers to this <b>Eva Welfare Organization</b> for research, field study, social work activities and for holistic development of the society.   |
| 05 | The School of Economics, DAVV shall bear all the expenditure/ cost included in the implementation and involvement and of its students and teachers for research, field study and social work activities.  |
| 06 | The School of Economics, DAVV shall also bear the traveling cost of their students and teachers during the visit to the organization.   |
| 07 | The School of Economics, DAVV shall nominate a Nodal Officer for this project.  |
| 08 | There will not be any direct financial inclusion between The School of Economics, DAVV, Indore and The <b>Eva Welfare Organization Indore</b> . Both the organization will be free to implement their activities as per their own budget provisions.  |
| 09 | The School of Economics, DAVV, Indore and The <b>Eva Welfare Organization, Indore</b> shall prepare a comprehensive plan for the integrated development of society. This will be a <b>joint mission</b> of both the organizations in the field of development.  |

तिल्लोर खुर्द के मध्य मेमोरेण्डम ऑफ अंडरस्टैंडिंग

- 1) यह MOU दिनांक 02/11/2019 से अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्व विद्यालय, इंदौर एवं ग्राम तिल्लोर खुर्द के मध्य लागू होगा। इस MOU के प्रथम भाग अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय, इंदौर जिसका कार्यालय खंडवा रोड इंदौर है, का प्रतिनिधित्व विभागाध्यक्ष, अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय इंदौर करेंगे या उनका प्रतिनिधि करेगा। दूसरे भाग का प्रतिनिधित्व तिल्लोर खुर्द गाँव के सरपंच या उनका प्रतिनिधि करेगा।
- 2) तिल्लोर खुर्द गाँव ग्रामीण विकास के कार्यों में शुरुवाती दिनों से जुड़ी हुई है, तिल्लोर खुर्द गाँव के सामने देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय, इंदौर इस कार्य में उनका सहभागी बनने का प्रस्ताव रखता है।
- 3) तिल्लोर खुर्द गाँव ने देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय इस प्रस्ताव को स्वीकार करते हुए उनसे जुड़कर परस्पर कार्य करने की सहमति दे दी है।
- 4) इसके अंतर्गत अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय, इंदौर अपने छात्रों एवं शिक्षकों को प्रतिनिधि के रूप में इस गाव मे शोध, फील्ड स्टडी, सामाजिक कार्य गतिविधियों एवं ग्रामवासियों के समग्र विकास हेतु प्रतिनिधि नियुक्त करेगा।
- 5) अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय, इंदौर इस प्रोजेक्ट के उद्देश्य हेतु अपने छात्रों एवं शिक्षकों के द्वारा इन गांवो मे शोध, फील्ड स्टडी, सामाजिक कार्य गतिविधियों सम्बंधित समस्त खर्च एवं लागत वहन करेगा।
- 6) अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय, इंदौर इस प्रोजेक्ट उद्देश्य हेतु छात्रों एवं शिक्षकों के ग्रामीण क्षेत्र में शोध अध्ययन पर किये गये यात्रा व्यय का भार भी वहन करेगा।

- 8) इस प्रोजेक्ट के सम्बन्ध में अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय एवं तिल्लोर खुर्द गाँव के मध्य कोई प्रत्यक्ष वित्तीय अनुबंध नहीं है। दोनों ही संस्थाए अपने बजट के प्रावधान के अनुसार क्रियाकलापों को कार्यान्वित करने के लिए स्वतंत्र रहेगी।
- 9) गाँव के समन्वित विकास के लिए अर्थशास्त्र अध्ययनशाला, देवी अहिल्या विश्वविद्यालय एवं तिल्लोर खुर्द ग्राम एक व्यापक नियोजन बनायेंगे, ग्रामीण विकास के क्षेत्र में दोनों ही संस्थाओं का यह एक संयुक्त मिशन होगा।

# **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MoU”) is entered on  
Tuesday, 20 July 2021 at Indore, Madhya Pradesh, India

**BY AND BETWEEN**



**Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Good Governance and  
Policy Analysis, Bhopal**

**AND**

**Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore**

## **About Atal Bihari Institute of Good Governance & Policy Analysis, Bhopal**

**Atal Bihari Institute of Good Governance & Policy Analysis (AIGGPA), Bhopal** to be represented by its CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER (CEO), AIGGPA (hereinafter referred to as "AIGGPA"), which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns OF THE FIRST PART.

**About Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya (DAVV), Indore to be represented by its REGISTRAR, DAVV, Indore (hereinafter referred to as "DAAA")**, which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns OF THE SECOND PART.

*AIGGPA and DAVV are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".)*

### **A. Objectives and Modes of Collaboration**

1. The goal of this Memorandum of Understanding is to foster collaboration, and provide opportunity for professional, scholarly and academic interaction in matters relating to Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge in these areas, based on reciprocity and mutual benefit. AIGGPA and DAVV agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaboration:
2. Holding collaborative programmes in the form of lectures, seminars, workshops, panel discussions, symposia, webinars, training programmes and the like in Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas.
3. Extending cooperation to each other in the areas of teaching, research, publication and other activities associated with Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas;
4. Preparation of Background Papers, Compendiums, White Papers, Dossiers, Policy Documents and the like on topical issues related to Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas, to be submitted to the Government, which could be of assistance to it, in policy formulation in those areas.
5. Publication of Proceedings of jointly-organized Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, Webinars, etc., as well as Background Papers, Compendiums, white papers, dossiers, policy documents and the like, on topical issues related to Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas.
6. Mutual sharing of infrastructure, resources and expertise in the organization of programmes and activities described above.

7. AIGGPA and DAVV agree that the following technical descriptions will guide each proposed activity identified and agreed upon by the two institutions.

### **B. Collaboration for Research and Development**

1. The Parties agree to investigate ways of identifying and inviting serving and retired civil servants, academicians, researchers, faculty members and other competent persons from the other institution to participate in ongoing research or development of programmes of mutual interest.
2. Further, the Parties agree to jointly identify and pursue opportunities for formulation and submission of new research project proposals or training programmes for possible funding by government and external agencies, if needed.
3. It is foreseen that when a member of either institution visits the other institution on invitation, or as part of such joint research project, or to organize a collaborative programme, such a visit will be subject to the regulations of the other Institution.
4. The parties agree to involve the students of AIGGPA and DAVV under apprenticeships/internships/research associates in various projects arising from time to time.
5. The parties also agree of launching of the joint online/offline/hybrid certificate programs on various topics as required from time to time, which can be on sharing model.

### **C. Exchange of Human Resources**

The Parties agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between researchers/faculty members from the two institutions. Specifically, the two institutions would identify appropriate researchers/faculty members as Principal Investigator(s)/Principal Co-Investigator(s) at their respective ends, and encourage members of their researchers/faculty to undertake short visits for lectures, facilitate research projects at either end, etc. The terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel, and housing, would be worked out between the partner institutions. The resource sharing of the reading/training materials at library can also be accessed mutually among the parties.

### **D. Intellectual Property**

AIGGPA and DAVV agree to respect each other's rights to Intellectual Property (IP). All background IP used in connection with this MoU shall remain the property of the Party that introduces it. No license is granted to any Party to use another Party's Background IP, unless specifically agreed to in writing. Further, the IP rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or joint activity under this MoU would be subject to separate written agreement/s on the ownership and management of such IP, and each Party agrees to respect the ownership of IP of the other Parties in all dealings, consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the partner institutions.

No Party to this Memorandum shall use the name, logo or any other designation of any of the other Parties without prior written consent.



### E. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for a period of five years. This MoU will be reviewed after 30 months; the terms of this MoU may be held rigid till the first review. Any extension to this MoU will be formally agreed to, in writing, by the Parties.


Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other Institution, six months in advance. Once terminated, neither Party will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other Institution may suffer. However, AIGGPA and DAVV will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

### F. Arbitration

Any issues that are not addressed or stipulated in the MoU shall be discussed and resolved through negotiation in good faith and such resolution will be incorporated as written amendments to the MoU by mutual agreement between two Parties.

No disputes are foreseen in the implementation of the MoU. The two Parties, however, agree that if any dispute arises between them, efforts will be made to settle the same as amicably as possible. If the dispute still remains unsettled, it will be referred for resolution bilaterally to CEO, AIGGPA and REGISTRAR, DAVV. The decisions so arrived at shall be final and binding on the parties to this MoU.
