Mission Statement: To Develop the Unique Tertiary Health Care Centre of the Vicinity with Medical and Paramedical Teaching and Research Facilities

Objectives:

- ✓ To provide basic health services and medical consultation to the students, employees and their families.
- ✓ To provide medical consultation and first aid to the beneficiaries in UTD premises.
- ✓ To provide facility for subsidized pathology investigations and dental and oral procedures for the beneficiaries in 2013.
- Provision of health insurance and/or tie up with some tertiary care hospital for the beneficiaries.
- ✓ To establish emergency treatment facility, minor operation theatre, subsidized radiology and specialists consultation.
- ✓ Have continuous health awareness and health checkup programs for the beneficiaries.



Location: Centrally located just adjoining the entrance of Takshashila Campus, Khandwa Road, Indore where all UTDs, boys and girls hostels are located.

Financial Resources: Rs. 125/- per student per semester is collected along with the semester fee. This in turn gets transferred from the respective departments to the chief warden's account and thus managed by the chief warden.

User Fees: No instant fee is payable at the time of examination or treatment. All available care is provided to the beneficiaries from the Health Centre.

Government Support: UGC grant is sanctioned for infrastructure, equipment and fixed expenses.











The centre, besides providing services at the health centre, has also extended medical services in the girl's hostels.

Facilities Available at Centre

Rooms:

Room amenities include patient examination rooms, dental check-up room, eye-check-up rooms and emergency beds.

Structure:

Building and Equipment:

- ✓ Building single story constructed in 2008
- ✓ One Health Centre In-charge room (furnished with basic facility furniture, almirah, computer with printer and A.C.
- One doctor's consultation room (furnished with basic facility furniture, A.C., examination table basic general examination equipment stethoscope, B.P. instrument and torch.
- ✓ One ECG cum consultation room (with a bed and ECG machine purchased in 2008)
- ✓ One dental surgeon's room (with a dental chair and A.C.)
- ✓ One treatment room (with basic first aid/dressing trolley) and basic antibiotic and symptomatic medicines)
- \checkmark One recovery room (with one bed and A.C.)
- ✓ One electric room (with one small inverter)
- ✓ One observation ward (with three beds, I/V stands and bedside lockers)
- ✓ One pathology lab (with microscope, semi auto-analyzer, refrigerator and electrolyte analyzer).
- ✓ Tap water connection and drinking water purification/cooling (UV water purification) facility of Health Centre are being used by the staff and doctors.

Meeting Room:

Meetings are not scheduled during running clinic. Patient's waiting hall is used as meeting room during non-clinical period. It is furnished with basic facilities like visiting chairs, almira, book shelf, weighing machine, LED television, office table, electric insect killer and A.C.

Outdoor Garden Size:

Grossly 100×25 feet on the south ward side 30×30 feet in front Eastward side 10×50 feet at the back Westward (yet to be developed as lawns).

Doctors and staff use their own mobile phones **Computer:** One for office work, located at the Health Centre In-charge's room and another at meeting room.

Facilities for Student Health files/Records:

Health Centre is associated with Shalby Multi-speciality Hospital, Indore since November 2017 to get benefits related to hospital care like consultation charges, investigation charges and room rent.

Facilities for Camps such as Eye-Checkup Camps, Blood Donation Camps: Usually sponsored free camps are preferred.

 ✓ One Blood donation Camp was organized at Health Centre on 22nd December 2017 registering a collection of >78 blood donations by M.Y. Hospital Blood Bank, Indore.





✓ Lions clubs international in collaboration with Health Centre, organized "The largest Diabetes Awareness Lesson" at IMS Auditorium, DAVV campus for the students and staff on 20th November 2017. This is in accordance with the international guidelines to make a Guinness world record. Thousand patients were screened.






Year 2018

इंदौर। एलएलबी फर्स्ट सेमेस्टर में सामूहिक नकल प्रकरण. में लिबरल कॉलेज ने डेढ़ महीने बाद यूनिवर्सिटी को जवाब दे दिया है। इसमें नक्रल से साफ इंकार किया गया है। यूनिवर्सिटी प्रशासन कमेटी से जांच करवाने पर अड़ा हुआ है, जिस पर इस सप्ताह फैसला लिया जाएगा। वहीं अधिकारी रिपोर्ट तैयार कर कुलपति के सामने रखने की तैयारी में जुट गए हैं।



बंद पड़ा था सेंटर : हेल्थ सेंटर बने 15 से ज्यादा दिन हो गए हैं, लेकिन जिम्मेदार इसकी तरफ ध्यान नहीं दे रहे थे। सूत्रों के मुताबिक 2010 में कुछ महीनों के लिए सेंटर बंद करना पड़ा था, क्योंकि ज्यादा समय डॉक्टर यहां ड्यूटी नहीं देते थे जबकि यूनिवर्सिटी ने इसके लिए अलग से बजट बना रखा है।
