

Summary Report: Teachers' Feedback Form



Following outcomes came out:


1. Syllabus is suitable to the course.




2. Syllabus is need based and regularly updated/revised.




3. Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teacher and students.




4. Course content is followed by corresponding reference materials.




5. Sufficient number of prescribed books are available in the Library.




6. The course/syllabus has good balance between theory and application.




7. The course/programme of studies carries sufficient number of optional papers.
