Slow Learners:

 Bilingual explanations and discussions are done in the class with the aim of reaching out to the slow learners so that they can be brought at par with the rest of the class.

 Personal, academic and career-related counselling is given from time to time by faculty members and seniors.

Advanced Learners: During lectures, tutorials, class tests, assignments and interaction outside the class, the teachers are able to assess the calibre of the students and identify the advanced learners. They are encouraged to help and provide support to the weaker students by engaging in group discussions and presentations.
