Bamboo Craft : as a craft heritage and tribal empowerment

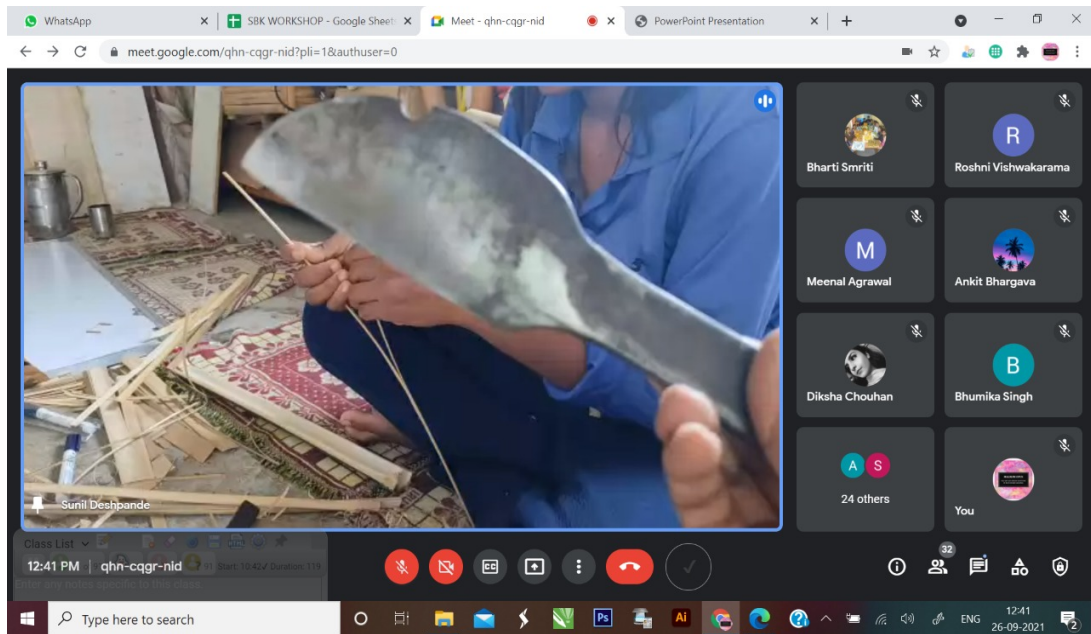


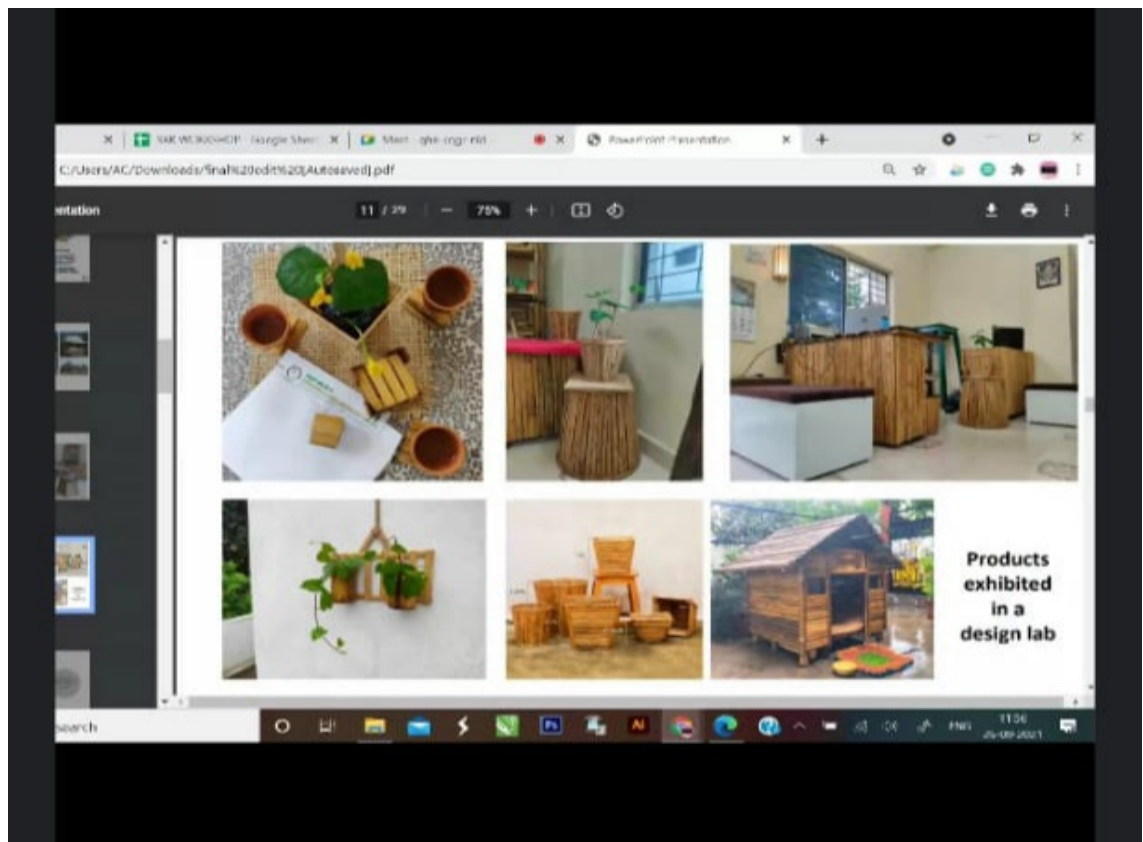
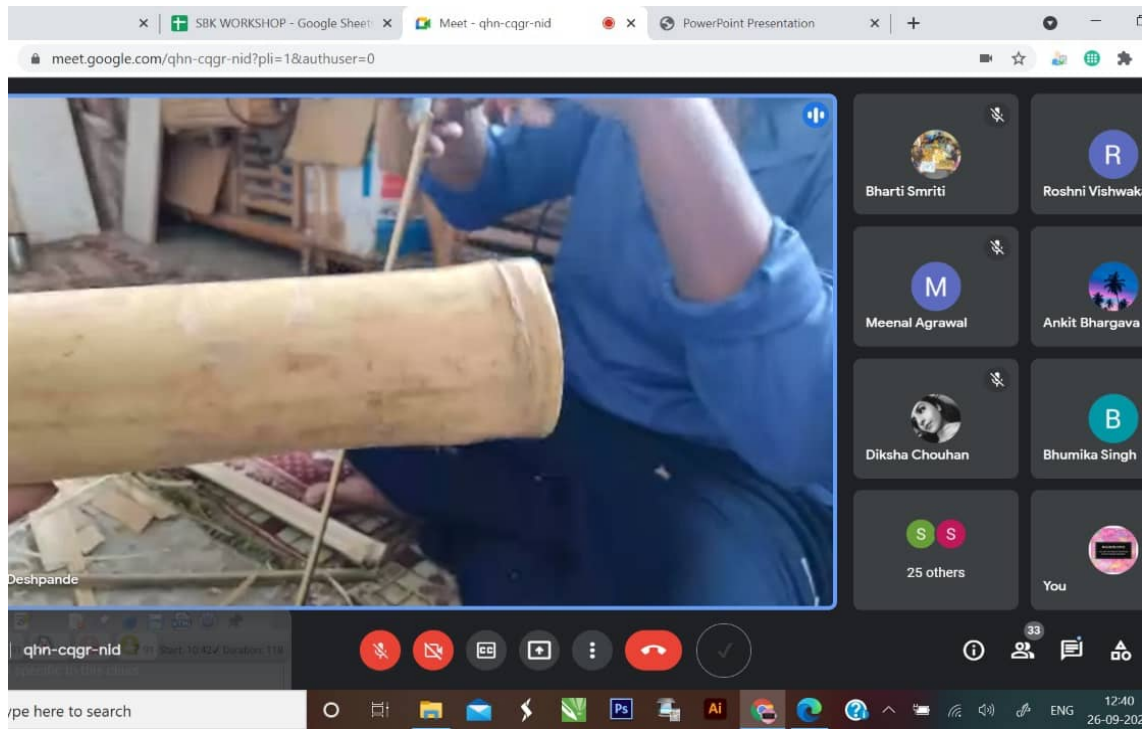
