**65th NATIONAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITIONS (NSCC)
(RIFLE EVENTS) AT THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, KERALA 2022**

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZERS

The National Rifle Association of India shall be organizing and conducting the 65th National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC) in Rifle Events in accordance with the rules of ISSF and NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended). These rules are available on the websites of ISSF and NRAI.

2. VENUE

The 65th National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC) in Rifle events will be held at Vattiyoorkkavu Shooting Range, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala from 20th November to 9th December 2022.

3. SCHEDULE

Schedule is attached at Annexure “A”

4. PARTICIPATION

- a.** Participation is open to competitors from State Rifle Associations/ Units affiliated to NRAI. In case where no State Rifle Association exists, competitors belonging to clubs directly affiliated with NRAI will be allowed to participate. NRAI members must take part through State Rifle Associations/ Units of their native place otherwise their entry will not be accepted. However, if there is no such Association / Club functioning in their State, they can take part as members of NRAI provided they have paid all their dues towards NRAI.





- b. State Rifle Associations/Units will allow the members of NRAI to participate in the competitions organized by NRAI without becoming a member of that State/Club to which he/she belongs subject to the member undertaking to follow all the rules and regulations applicable to the shooters of that State. The State Rifle Associations/units may also charge an additional fee equal to entry fee of the competition but not more than Rs. 5000/- for forwarding the entries of Life/Annual Members of NRAI. This is applicable when these shooters are not members of State/Unit or any District/club to which Members of NRAI wish to represent. The Members of NRAI must have achieved MQS as defined for each competition under NRAI Match Book.

5. AGE CRITERIA

- a. Participation in various age category matches will be as per Rule 11 of NRAI Match Book. The age of the shooter (senior, junior, Master and Senior Master) will be calculated from the first day of the competition, (20th November 2022).
- b. **SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS AS ON FIRST DAY OF THE COMPETITION ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.**

6. ELIGIBILITY

Shooters qualified, as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended) are eligible to participate in this NSCC. **Shooters furnishing incorrect information shall be Debarred from taking part in any Shooting championship/competition for Two years including blocking the Shooter ID account.**

7. ENTRY

- a. Those shooters, who have not received/ applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.
- b. **SHOOTERS, WHO ARE ALREADY IN POSSESSION OF SHOOTER ID, ARE NOT REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR FRESH ID REGISTRATION AND ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON EXISTING REGISTRATION.**





- c. The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. Entries will only be accepted through “NRAI’s ONLINE SYSTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till **09.00 PM on 30th OCTOBER 2022**. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till **09.00 PM** on 02nd November 2022.
- d. **Please note it takes more than 72 hours for your entry to reach on NRAI system, hence shooters should not contact or send email to NRAI immediately after filing their entries. It is informed that the State Rifle Associations have the right to reject your entry within 72 hours.**
- e. Shooters may contact Mr. Anjan Singh in NRAI office on phone number +91-9555046539 during working hours for any assistance. Shooters may also send email on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com NO CALLS WILL BE RESPONDED AFTER OFFICE HOURS.
- f. Juniors, Youth and Sub Youth shooters can also participate in senior category with the payment of additional entry fee as per rules.
- g. Shooters, who achieve ISSF MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended) will be notified as “Renowned Shooter”.
- h. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid “online” only, and no cash/draft will be accepted. Shooters will be permitted to shoot in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained.
- i. **Foreign Nationals must part in matches, specifically for Foreign Nationals and are not permitted to participate in National Championship matches. In case of any violation, the shooter will be disqualified from participation in this NSCC.**
- j. DETAILS WILL BE PUBLISHED ON THE WEBSITE OF NRAI AFTER CLOSE OF ENTRIES (WITH TRIPLE FEE). No emails will be replied on this subject till the deadlines are over.
- k. **Special Instructions for Deaf Shooters**
- i. Shooters, who wish to submit their entries in the Deaf Category, should fill their entries through NRAI’s online entry system by visiting the website www.thenrai.org in Deaf category matches and subject to achieving MQS under **Deaf Category**. They will also have to submit an Audiogram conducted by a Government Hospital to AISCD at aiscd1965@gmail.com. In absence of this certificate, entries are liable to be rejected.





- ii. Entries for NSCC will be accepted in the deaf category only after verification of Audiogram by AISCD.
- iii. Deaf shooters may also submit entry in able body shooters category subject to achieving MQS for Deaf Category shooters
- iv. At the 65th NSCC, Deaf Shooters will shoot matches with hearing aids. The score of the match will be considered for both Deaf category and able body shooter category as well.
- v. Deaf Shooters who have participated in the Deaflympics 2022 can upload their audiogram in their profile directly. They can also participate in other events at the NSCC being International Shooters.

8. EVENTS

9. TEAM REPRESENTATION

Team events will be conducted in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book 2022 (amended). Only one Team from each State/ Unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants in National Championship Category. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 17.00 Hrs on **our online portal** www.thenrai.org

10. MIXED TEAM EVENTS

The Mixed Team events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries before **02.00 PM on 20th NOVEMBER 2022** at **NRAI Camp office at Vattiyoorkkavu Shooting Range, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala**. Only one team per category, consisting of one male and one female of the same state/unit, can be fielded. **Entry fee is Rs. 6000/- per team.**

11. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book 2022 (Amended). The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-.

12. AMMUNITION

- a. The ammunition will be issued to the Team Manager only against cash payment on valid Arms Licenses of Associations/ Clubs/ Individuals or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity are obtained from the Local Licensing Authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to NRAI without any exception.
- b. In extra ordinary circumstances, the Organizing Secretary may grant permission for use of a common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be advised together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable him to work out details for conduct of relevant matches.

13. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels for all budgets are available in Trivandrum.

14. GENERAL

- a. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.





- b. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- c. Penalty of Rs. 200/- will be charged if a shooter loses his/her competitor card during the competition and fresh card will only be issued on deposit of penalty.
- d. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- e. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- f. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited. In case of any violation, disciplinary action shall be initiated, and shooter may be debarred from taking part in NSCC.
- g. Accompanying person/personal coaches are not permitted to enter the Field of Play (FOP).
- h. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- i. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- j. Scores of this NSCC will be considered for selection of National Squad and international teams under the Selection Criteria, which will be published before the start of the NSCC.
- k. The Selection of National Squad and international teams will be done in accordance with the Selection Policy.
- l. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The details of squads will be notified on the website of NRAI. Shooters are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.





m. COVID PROTOCOLS:

- i. Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/Kerala Govt. as and when in force.
- ii. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID– 19 reports.

15. CODE OF CONDUCT

- a. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- b. Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of NRAI.
- c. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- d. Follow directions by officials.
- e. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- g. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- h. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
- i. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- j. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- k. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- l. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.





- m. It's the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- n. Shooter is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
- o. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
- p. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
- q. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
- r. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- s. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
