The institution extends its umbrella of support across age demographics, spanning from 6 to those beyond the age of 18.

Work Done/Observations/Learnings:

- The organizational framework accommodates a substantial cohort of children and adults navigating the terrain of special needs. However, a discernible lacuna persists in the realm of individualized personal care.
- The staff, while embodying a convivial disposition, grapple with inherent limitations in understanding the distinctive conditions of each student, a predicament exacerbated by the organization's magnitude.
- A confidential repository, under the stewardship of the NGO's head, meticulously catalogs sensitive information pertaining to the medical, physical, and mental health conditions of the students.
- The institution's commitment to comprehensive support is underscored by the provision of a daycare facility, emblematic of their holistic approach.

Observations on Abhijet:

Amidst the kaleidoscope of students, particular scrutiny was directed towards Abhijet, a 19-year-old luminary navigating the spectrum of autism disorder. Discerning observations illuminate Abhijet's proactive demeanor, his role as a de facto leader within the class, and a predilection for more animated interactions compared to his peers. Despite grappling with impediments such as being non-vocal and harboring a reticence, Abhijet showcases commendable autonomy by attending to mundane tasks like washing his lunch box. Furthermore, his grasp of rudimentary arithmetic, coupled with active participation in daily rituals, sets him apart.

Objectives/Purpose of Visit:

The primary objectives of this visit were multifold. Firstly, it sought to gain a nuanced understanding of the diverse services offered by Happy Homes in addressing the complex issue of substance abuse. Its commitment to societal welfare is articulated in its mission statement, emphasizing the prevention of harm caused by substance abuse and the restoration of individuals to a healthier and more fulfilling life.

Work Done/Observations/Learnings:

- **Services:**

Happy Homes offers a comprehensive suite of services, catering to a spectrum of addictions including opioids, alcohol, and illicit drugs. Beyond mere detoxification, the center delves into behavioral issues, mood disorders, and provides family counseling, notably favoring an outpatient model to ensure sustained support.

- **Admission Process:**

The admission process is characterized by both voluntary and involuntary pathways. Indirect admissions, often involving a rescue process, underscore the urgency in certain cases. The 90-day standard initial phase allows for a meticulous assessment of each individual's unique circumstances. The Acute Care Unit (ACU), akin to an intensive care unit, manages withdrawal symptoms with a structured approach during the critical initial 15 days.

- **Treatment Process:**

Detoxification, a crucial phase especially for alcohol dependency, unfolds over five days and involves the administration of saline solutions. Post-detox, the rehabilitation journey integrates diverse therapeutic approaches, such as cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT),

art therapy, music therapy, and recreational activities. The Psychosocial Rehabilitation Plan, unfolding over six days, tailors interventions to individual needs.

- **Aftercare and Intervention:**

The center prioritizes a structured aftercare process, which includes the formulation and implementation of a Relapse Prevention Plan (Rob) and a Crisis Plan. Family involvement is emphasized throughout the recovery process, with exclusive therapy sessions dedicated to female patients.

Conclusion:

The visit to Happy Homes Rehabilitation Centre provided profound insights into their comprehensive and compassionate approach to addiction rehabilitation. Beyond the clinical aspects, the center's commitment to ongoing care, tailored interventions, and family involvement underscores a holistic philosophy towards recovery. Happy Homes

Work Done/Observations/Learnings:

Educational Levels:

- **Aarambh (The Beginning):**

This foundational level is tailored for beginners, where the focus is on fundamental skills. The curriculum includes training on setting, behavior, proper communication, hygiene, and toilet training for autistic kids.

- **Adhayan (The Learning):**

In the second level, known as Adhayan, individuals progress in their learning journey. Here, the emphasis is on promoting new learning, and children are encouraged to understand and appreciate their unique gifts bestowed by God.

- **Aatmnirbhar (The Self-Reliant):**

The third level signifies self-reliance and independence. Individuals are guided to identify and harness their talents, transforming them into strengths. Notably, they are involved in various initiatives, including handmade businesses and a unique cafe, fostering a sense of self-sustainability.

Initiatives:

- **Cafe Project:**

Arunabh runs a cafe staffed by autistic children and adults. Beyond offering delightful food, this initiative empowers individuals with training in billing, simple mathematics, and customer interactions. The cafe also sells pulses and grains packaged by the individuals, contributing to their self-sustainability.

- **Handmade Businesses:**

The center engages individuals in various handmade businesses, including creating posters, fridge magnets, and other crafts. They are taught how to exhibit their creations, allowing them to earn money independently.

Environment:

- The atmosphere at Arunabh is a harmonious blend of a homely and educational setting. During our visit, children showcased their abilities in communication, singing, and dancing, creating an environment where they felt both at home and in school simultaneously.
- Trained teachers, possessing both knowledge and empathy, contribute to creating a supportive environment that fosters growth and learning.


Comparative Structure:
