Exhibition cum Sale - Handloom on Wheels

An Exhibition cum sale organized by the Department of Lifelong Learning, DAVV associate with Department of Cottage & Rural Industries, Government of Madhya Pradesh, Sant Ravidas Madhya Pradesh Handicrafts and Handloom Development Corporation, Madhya Pradesh Khadi Rural Industries Board and Madhya Pradesh Self Federation Silk Directorate at our department on 'khadi textile' industry, to spread awareness among youth for hand woven fabrics. Hand-woven fabrics are made by hand, using a handloom, which does not require electricity or produce any pollution. In addition, only women are given jobs for making Khadi cloth so that they can become independent and self-reliant. A person can weave only 7 to 8 meters of cloth in a day. Khadi is completely chemical free, dyes used for these are natural dyes, which we get it from vegetable and flowers. There are many forms of Khadi some are cotton, silk, linen and it is also available in many different designs and prints, out of which bagh print, batik print and bandhani is famous.

Apart from this, a competition is also being organized in which the participants have to prepare a design promoting Khadi industry. Rules for the competition are:

- Raw clothes can be taken only from government shops, whose bill you have to show with your designed clothes. Only then your design will be considered for competition.
- Theme ethnic and casual wear.
- Only one or two participants can take part.
- The last date to submit your prototype is 30 th September.

The fashion show which will be held at the Shelton Hotel on 2^{nd} October will showcase these designs. Prize will be given to the winner and participants will also be given participation certificates. You can take your designs with you after the competition.

We learned and understood many things about khadi textile from the workshop. We are very glad that we were able to attend the workshop.
