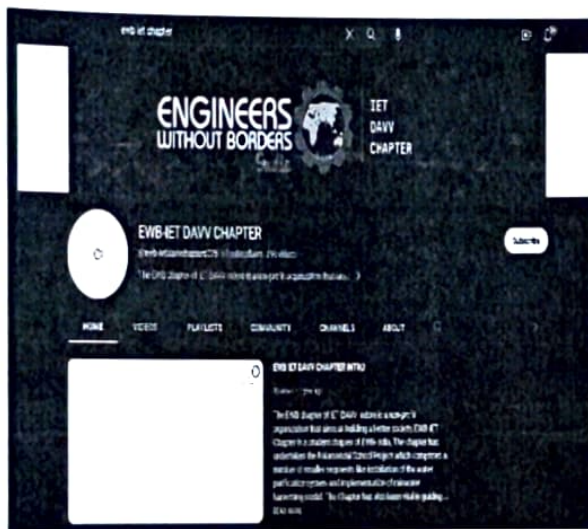
4.a EVENT NAME: YouTube Channel

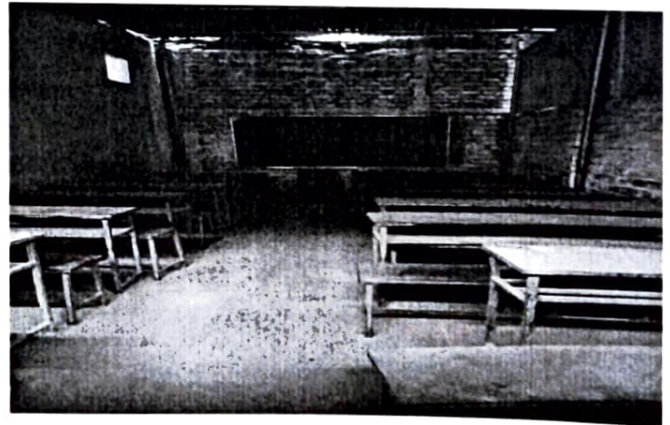
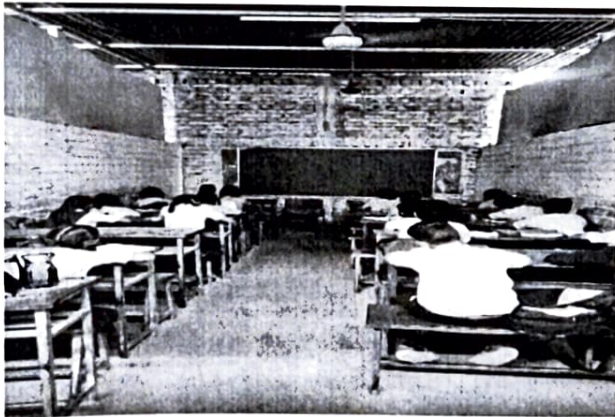
**6.a EVENT NAME: Ujyara 2 Project**

**6.b DATE: January 2023**

**6.c No. of Students participated: 10**

**6.d Event Details :-**

Executed by EWB-IET DAVV Indore Student Chapter, the Ujyara 2 project successfully improved lighting conditions at Shri Bal Vigyan Shishu Vihar H.S. School, Dhar Road, Loknayaak Nagar, Indore. A luminous 110 Watt 12 V Solar Panel, certified by IEC, was securely installed on the terrace of Shri Bal Vigyan Shishu Vihar H.S. School's primary building to supplement the existing electricity infrastructure. The solar panel was connected to a solar inverter, serving as both a charge controller and inverter circuit. A 120Ah tubular battery powered LED lights, transforming previously dim classrooms into brightly lit spaces. Havells LED tube lights (10 W) were strategically installed in the classrooms of Shri Bal Vigyan Shishu Vihar H.S. School, significantly improving the learning environment. The successful implementation, documented with attached photos, notably improved lighting conditions for approximately 400 students, aged 5-18 years, at Shri Bal Vigyan Shishu Vihar H.S School. This initiative addressed the financial constraints of the school, ensuring a well-lit educational environment.
