



1. Student Feedback for Faculty

Feedback from students was taken on faculty using Five point Likert scale ranging from 1 to 5 in which 1 indicates very poor and 5 indicates very good. Given chart depict the parameter wise mean score of the same:



The mean score of parameters namely ability to bring conceptual clarity, teacher's subject knowledge, completion & coverage of course, relevance of syllabus as per industry requirement is more than 3.7 which shows that teacher are able to bring the conceptual clarity and complete the syllabus timely. Further, syllabus is as per the requirement of industry requirements. As the score is comparatively low in teacher's regularity and class controlling ability, necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the these parameters.



According to analysis of student feedback on faculty, the faculty's regularity, subject knowledge, completion of course and relating theory with examples are having above 3.4 mean score. But faculties are having less interaction and guidance outside the classroom, as average score is 3.2 approximately in the mentioned parameter. Necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the parameters in which mean score is not satisfactory especially interaction & guidance outside the classroom and motivation provided by teacher




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1. Student Feedback for Faculty

Feedback report of management stream students for faculty is showing mean score of over 3.6 for all the parameters. Although, means scores are satisfactory but the further improvement in the mean scores, necessary action was taken by the Institute.





Feedback from management and computer students was taken for the Institute using Five point Likert scale ranging from 1 to 5 in which 1 indicates strongly disagree and 5 indicates strongly agree. Given chart depict the parameter wise mean score of the same;



Analysis report of student's feedback on Institute shows that students are satisfied with the availability of books, internet, software's, and basic requirements, as average score received is above 3.2. But, students have given 2.8 mean score for cleanliness of classroom and photocopy of the study material at the institute.



Analysis of students feedback on Institute overall shows that availability of books, basic learning requirements and resources are having mean score of above 2.9. However, cleanliness of classroom and technological support is having low average of 2.7. Further, students are comparatively satisfied with the availability of basic requirements at the institute. Necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the parameters in which mean score is not satisfactory especially for the cleanliness, technological support etc.





The above chart depicts the student feedback on the faculties of courses for the year 2016. The average score for the Institute is above 3.4 across all areas covered in the questionnaire. Although, scores for all the parameters are more than 3.4 except two teacher's ability to bring conceptual clarity and interaction & guidance outside the classroom, necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the all parameters.



The analysis revealed that students are not satisfied with level of course completion in the class, to improve the mean score in the parameter, the Institute has put more attention on weekly report and instructed all faculty members to submit course completion report before all examinations. Further, mean scores for the parameters namely teacher's regularity and punctuality, use of theory and practical examples, communication skills and use of case/ assignment etc is more than good.







Although, mean score for the some parameters like teacher's subject knowledge, ability to control the class, completion & coverage of course and relevance of syllabus as per industry requirement is more than 4 which means students feel more than good for all these parameters as compared to other parameters, necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the parameters in which mean score less than 4.



The above chart depicts the student feedback on the faculties of courses for the year 2017. The average score for the Institute is above 3.47 across all areas covered in the questionnaire. Students are satisfied with teacher's ability to control the class, the way of handling of cases /assignment/exercises/activities in the class and motivation provided by teacher to the students. Necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the parameters in which mean score is not comparatively satisfactory in respect of other parameters.





Analysis report of student's feedback on Institute shows that students are satisfied with the availability of books, internet, software's, and basic requirements, as average score received is above 3.2. But, students have given 2.6 mean score for cleanliness of classroom and photocopy of the study material at the institute. The Institute has initiated to give work of cleanliness on contract to outside agency. The process is in the final stage. Further, to improve the mean score of all other parameters, the Institute has taken necessary action.



In the light of above data, it is found that student's agree that institute provides the necessary basic requirements, internet, software and other facilities, as average is 3.2. However, student's feedback also shows that cleanliness of classroom and technological support provided by the institute is having score of 2.6 which is comparatively too low. The Institute has initiated to give work of cleanliness on contract to outside agency. The process is in the final stage. Further, to improve the mean score of all other parameters, the Institute has taken necessary action. Further, budgetary provision has been made to improve the technical support at the Institute. As the mean score of all other parameters is not too high, the Institute has taken necessary action to improve the same.




1. Student Feedback on Curriculum

The above chart depicts student feedback on Management courses for the academic year 2018. The mean score across all parameters, except one namely the laboratory experiments enhanced my understanding of the concepts and enabled me to relate theory to practice (Experiential learning), is >3.0.

As the mean score of the parameter namely 'Laboratory experiments enhanced my understanding of the concepts and enabled me to relate theory to practice' is lowest i.e. 2.92, the Institute have introduced laboratory-based courses such as SPSS, data visualization, data analytics, etc. Further, necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement in the all other parameters in which mean score is not satisfactory or comparatively low.



The analysis reveled that the mean score of two parameter namely relevance of programme for career avenues in future and the units/sections in the syllabus are properly sequenced is highes i.e. more than 3.78, rest of all other parameters mean score is comparatively low. Necessary action was taken by the Institute for the improvement rest all the parameters especially coverage of syllabus by the faculty in the class, revision of the syllabus in the light of skills required in the industries. The Institute conducted two scheme and syllabus revision workshops in the light of feedback received from students on curriculum.





Action Taken

A mean score of 2.2 in the area of cleanliness was a result of under-staffing. The issue has been resolved by the Institute as a contract of cleanliness has already been given to the Housekeeping agency. Further, for batter technical support, new budgetary provisions are to be made to purches more LCD projectors etc.



The above chart depicts the student feedback on the Institute by students pursuing computer courses during the the year 2018. Parameter like availability of books, basic requirements, internet facility etc hold average score of above 3.1. However, technological support and photocopy of study material has got lower average of 2.8. Also, cleanliness in the institute has average of 2.9.

Action Taken

Mean scores of photocopy of study material and technological supports is lowest among all parameters, the Institute is in the process to provide photocopy facility for the students also. Although, a photocopy machine available at the campus on paid basis for the students. A mean score of 2.9 in the area of cleanliness was a result of under-staffing. The issue has been resolved by the Institute as a contract of cleanliness has already been given to the Housekeeping agency. Further, for batter technical support, new budgetary provisions are to be made to purchase more LCD projectors etc.







In the light of the feedback given by faculties, the institute is in the process to increase number of books for variety of courses in the library. The faculties has already been asked to recommend books in the library.




