Topic Satellite in Education: Edusat in the Teacher Training and Education

This session gave us information on Satellite. Dr. Mishra started his session by history of satellite and broadcasting. At the starting just 3 satellites were placed in a particular path known as 'Geostationary orbit'. In India, the first satellite communication was conducted in the year 1975-76 with ATS-6 loaned by USA to the Government of India for one year to use satellite in transmitting TV programmes to remote villages in the region. To support the challenge and vision ISRO launched EDUSAT, a satellite, exclusively dedicated to education on September 20, 2004 with the major objectives to provide support to both formal and non-formal education system in India through low cost ground system. He introduced us with INSAT 3A KU band transponder for distance learning programme. Multimedia distance education system through UGC-CEC for higher education, IGNOU for distance education, NCERT for school education, AICTE for technical education was explained. So, uses and limitations of EDUSAT were understood by us well.

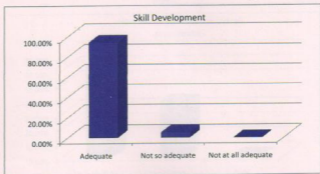

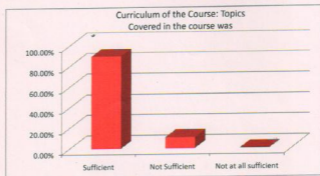
