She explained the various activities carried out under the agis of this institute; the different initiatives taken for instainable livelihood in the village of Sanawadiya and the efforts towards achieving and enhancing women empowerment.

Resource Person: Prof.S.N. Choudhary , Rajiv Gandhi Chair Professor, BU. Bhonal

Sustainable Rural Livelihood - A sociological perspective. Dr. Choudhary explained the three characteristics of sustainability - Stability, productivity and equity through various examples from rural and tribal culture like customs enforced- not to cut forests leading sustainable development.

Dr. Joshi explained the sustainable livelihood from natural resources. Joint Forest Management 1988, proved beneficial for conserving the forests as community within a radius of 5 km help in managing the forests and therby protecting the forests.

Field Visit to Dhamnod Villages

Villages under National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) were visited by the group. Group members had the interaction with self help group village women. Project Facilitation Team members from NRLM explained how they form the SHG and how they are linked with Banks after 3 months of successful functioning of the SHG. Participants had an interaction with village women of three SHG Groups.

Resource Person: Mr. Pankaj Panday, District Manager, NRLM

Mr. Panday focused on fine details of self help group – why is SHG important, how they are made community based monitoring system is the key of SHG. SHG tackles many problems of poor community and bring social change in the rural communities.


