Resource Person: Mr. Pankaj Panday, District Manager, NRLM

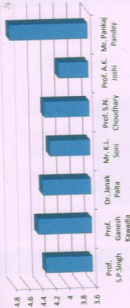

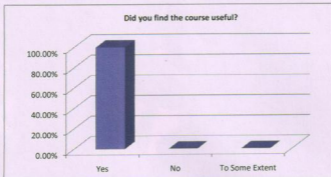
