Day: 1 Date: 7/6/2016

Session: 1

Time: 10:30 to 1:30
Resource Person: Dr. Namrata Sharma
Topic: Registration and Inauguration

Dr. Namrata Sharma; Director, Academic Staff Collage with co-ordinator Dr Bupesh Gupta Welcomed the participants. Dr. Namarata briefed the participants about what they can expect from the course as it flows on. Detail insights were provided on by madam on various activities, assignment and various criteria of evaluation of the course. The participants were encouraged to be punctual and since, and have an attitude of learning towards all the lectures during the orientation programme the lecture was proceeded by Dr. Kamakshi Agnihotri

Session: 2
Time: 2:30 pm to 5:30 pm
Resource Person: Dr.Kamakshi Agnihotri
Topic: Constructivism

The resource person started with the roots of philosophy and then connected it to psychology. She discussed about the major terms coined in psychology, the latest of which is constructivism. In later part of lecture the history of constructivism was disused which included five major theories of constructivism. She concluded the lecture by discussing the constructivism class. She also helped the participants to know the major difference between traditional and constructivist class.

Day: 2 Date: 8/6/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30 to 1:30 Resource Person: Dr. Kamakshi Agnihotri Topic: Curriculum designing & development

Dr. Agnihotri started the session with the difference between Aims, Objectives & Goals. He initially talked about the difference between curriculum & Syllabus which was followed by how a curriculum is designed. She discussed about the sources of curriculum designs and the various modes of evaluation in examination. Later she discussed in detail about the types of curriculum designs and concluded the class with format of curriculum. The session helped the participant to understand the dynamics of curriculum development which is very necessary for all the teachers.

Session: 2 Time: 2:30 to 5:30 Resource person: Dr Madhuika Varma Topic: Educational Technology

At the Outset the resource person started the discussion about Measurement, Evaluation & Assessment she discussed the basic difference between assessment and evaluation. After which she detailed the participants about Formation and Cumulative assessment. She underlined the significance of different level of questions & the interrogative verbs associated with them. The session benefited the participants, as it helped them to understand the minor difference between the terminologies used during designing the question paper. The lecture was concluded with a detail discussion on Questionnaire that explained the meanings of the interrogatives used while question paper designing, in form of Multiple choice questions.

Day: 3 Date: 9/6/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30 to 1:30 Resource Person: Dr. Madhulika Varma Topic: Curriculum Designing

In this session the resource person focused particularly on step of curriculum development. She detailed the participants about the essential considerations for curriculum development. She discussed in detail the different phases involved while we design & implement a curriculum for course. She also helped the participants to understand the complex procedure involved in the process of curriculum planning and the stakeholders who are put into consideration during the process.

Dr. Ira Bapna delivered a multifaceted lecture on stress management which was decorated with many small stories and video clipping, which gave the participants a deep insight on how to manage stress & be positive towards life. Day: 4 Date: 10/6/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30 to 1:30 Resource Person: Dr. Bunesh Gupta Topic: Spiritual learning

He made the session quite interesting by stressing on self learning & making the ultimate journey towards almighty. Day: 5 Date: 11/6/2016

Topic: Introduction to computers

Later he discussed about the long & complex procedure of accreditation and the criteria on which institutions are assessed. He also shared with participant the new grading system which will come in effect from 1 July 2016.

Day: 6 Date: 13/6/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30 to 1:30 Resource person: Dr Anand Kar Topic: Writing a Research Paper Proposal

Dr. Anand Kar initially focused on the research quality of India. He shared the tips to be followed while conducting research & publishing it. He discussed in detail about all the components of research paper. Later in his session, he detailed the participants about the format of title page & covering letter.

He concluded the letter session with detail description of references and its types. He discussed three major references which includes references for:

- a) Edited books
- b) Textbooks

c) Original Research Papers

Session: 2 Time: 2:30 to 5:30 Resource person: Dr. Arun Khrawt Topic: Team Based Learning and Concept Mapping

Beginning with the tutorials, Dr. Arun linked the tutorials to the team based learning. He discussed with participants how mind mapping can be used to solve and explain complex topics to students. He focused on both the teaching method to improve the interaction between students & teachers. He concluded the lecture by advising participants to inculate the methodologies in their classroom teaching. Day: 7 Date: 14/6/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30 to 1:30 Resource Person: Dr. Ganesh Kawadiya Topic: Globalisation & Indian Economy

"A good teacher makes complex concept, simple." This is what Dr. Ganesh did for the participants while explaining the difficult concept of globalisation, with simple instances from day to life. The resource person explained the merits & loose pool of Globalisation process. Later he discussed about major components of Globalisation which were:

- (a) World trading org
- (b) Euro currency
- (c) Technological Upgradation
- (d) Global crises.

Session: 2 Time: 2:30 pm to 5:30pm Resource person: Dr. Arun Khrawat Topic: Choice Based Credit System

Dr. Arun continued his topic from previous day & discussed about various aspect of assessment & Evaluation system followed in India. He discussed in detail about the different evaluation system followed in India and how the systems need to be reviewed as they are more teacher centred and not student centred.

Later He detailed the participants on how CBCS is recent and most suited method of evaluation. He discussed in detail about the complete peripheral & implementation of CBCS.

Day: 8 Date: 15/06/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30-1:30 Resource person: Mr. Nitin David Topic: Gender Sensitization

"People don't remember, what you said to them but remember how you made them feel." this session was more dedicated to inculcate moral values and sensitivity than being more successful as a teacher. Davis Sir organised various small group activities, which gave participant are great insight into a sensitive issue like gender sensitization. The session was concluded on a very sensitive note, that before being a teacher we must always try to be a good human being.

Session: 2 Time: 2:30 to 5:30 Resource Person: Dr. Ganesh Kewadiya Tonic: Gram Panchyat

The session was started with a video clip which explained the process of implementation of gram panchyat model in one of the village in Mahanshtra and the people associated with it. The resource person detailed the participants about the concept of rural development in India and it's crucial for a developing country like India, where 60% of population still resides in village.

Later He discussed about the different rural development schemes launched by the government of India for holistic development of rural areas. The session was concluded with focus on three key components of rural management, which were:

Day: 9 Date: 16/6/2016

Session: 1 Time: 10:30 to 1:30 Resource Person: Mr. Nitin David Topic: Public Speaking

It was a completely interactive session, where the participants initiated many public speaking activities. The resource person made the session very interesting by giving first hand experiences to all the participants in the area of public speaking, voice modulation, correct punctuation, right body postures and mostly important the attitude with which to come on stage.

It was a wonderful session where small activities have built deep lessons of right personality and team building. The session was concluded with a very emotion documentary with a message of wearing helmet and following the safety rules.

After deep analysis & interpretation of clip, major Leadership traits were analysed and discussed amongst the participants who were also backed by the real life experiences of participants. He told the importance of industry — academia interface for the development of research in higher education institution. On the Outset the lecture focused on the meaning of conflict and the major reasons on which conflict is created in an organization. The resource person made it clear that conflicts cannot be eliminated from an organisation, but it can be successfully mitigated for increasing the efficiency of employees.
